Jason Geer joined the Michigan Chamber of Commerce in January of 2011 as Small Business Advocate & Chamber Partnership Manager. In January of 2013, Jason was promoted to Director of Energy and Environmental Policy. Jason directs the Chamber's Energy & Environment Committee and is responsible for working directly with the state legislature and state agencies to implement the Chamber's legislative priorities.

Jason came to the Michigan Chamber from the Midland Area Chamber of Commerce where he served as the Director of Government Affairs.
